- To address barriers to Medicaid Transformation implementation through standardization across Standard Plans and Tailored Plans;
- Collaborate to develop a process for crisis and urgent hand-offs in ongoing Transition of Care;
- Promote standardization for Network Providers and address concerns of providers that will be operating across Standard and Tailored Plans, when possible;
- Assure stability of the Behavioral Health/IDD Crisis services system during Medicaid Transformation;

- **Goals:** The goals of the PHP LME/MCO Workgroup include:
- Promote standardization and collaboration in crisis service definitions, reporting, transition/discharge processes and data collection;
- Collaborate and coordinate efforts around Community Crisis Planning;
- Provide feedback and promote collaboration on the implementation of the Advanced Medical Home model across Standard and Tailored Plans;
- Promote consistency and work collaboratively with the Transition of Care Workgroup on EPSDT and Transition of Care issues; and
- Coordinate educational and outreach efforts to promote communication with Social Determinant of Health Providers and community stakeholders, specifically around transition of care.
